## Heads Up!

### Campaign Website - 2014 Legislative Session

**Important Information!** ALL VERBIAGE AND VISUALS REFERENCING "SOLICITING" CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS MUST BE REMOVED FROM CAMPAIGN WEBSITES DURING A LEGISLATIVE SESSION.



- You may state, "*Campaign contributions cannot be accepted during a legislative session*".



- However, you may not include a statement similar to, "*Check back after session for information on how to donate*".

AS 24.60.031(b) A legislator may not request or accept a contribution, or a promise, or pledge to make a contribution, for the legislator's own campaign for state or municipal office, while the legislature is in regular or special session.

## Additional Session Fundraising Restrictions

### Legislator

A legislator may not solicit or accept a contribution or a promise or pledge to make a contribution:

- ♦ for another candidate in an election for municipal, state or federal office;
- ♦ to influence a state ballot proposition or question; or for a political party

### Legislative Employee

- ♦ Only restricted to state or municipal candidates.
